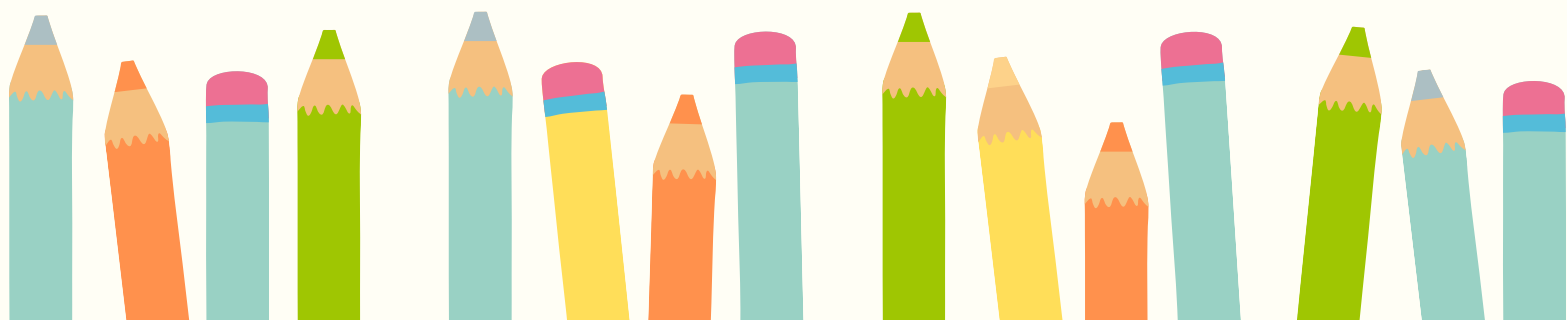
About Us

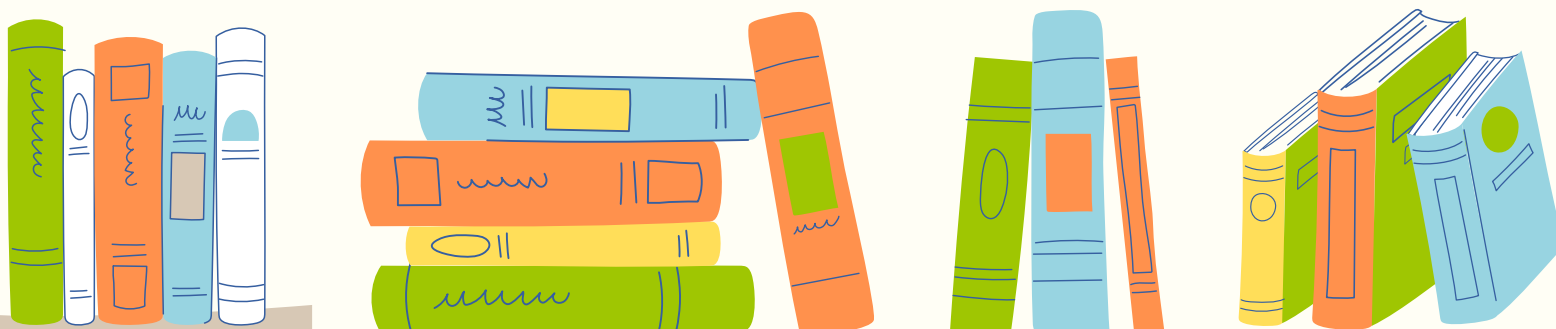


About Us

The AllKids program is focused on the coastal commune of Ream in Sihanouk Province, Cambodia. In 2012, more than 25% of children were not attending school. For those children enrolled in school, attendance rates were poor.

As of 2021, there are **502** children on the Kids to School program with the objective of having as many of these children as possible achieve high school grade 12.

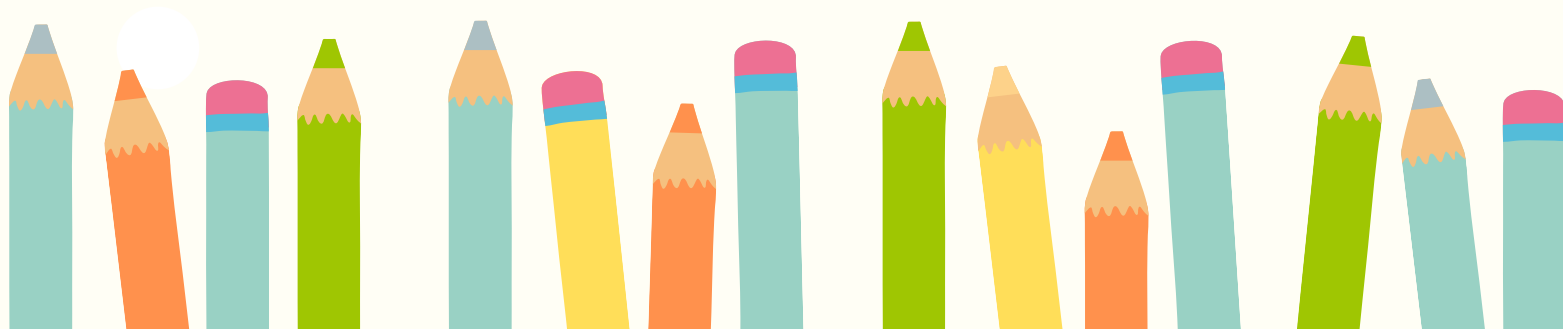
The AllKids Learning Centres offer additional tuition for all children in the community to provide programs not available in public schools including English, IT, Khmer Literacy, Art, Performance and Sport. There are currently over 700 children enrolled for classes.





History

- 2012** AllKids officially became a not-for-profit, international non-Government organization.
- 2013** The first AllKids Learning Centre opened in Smach Daeng.
- 2014** AllKids Day Care Centre in Smach Daeng opened.
- 2017** AllKids opened a second day care house at K'Bal Hong which cares for 30 children.
- 2020** The second learning centre opened in K'Bal Hong. This has given over 140 children access to a range of educational activities without having to leave the safety of their own community.





Child Sponsorship

There are many reasons why children don't attend school in Cambodia. The primary cause is usually related to poverty. AllKids work closely with the local public schools, government and commune officials, and the families of Ream to find solutions which enable all children in their community to receive a good education.

The Problems

Although public school education is free in Cambodia, many families have difficulty meeting the cost of school uniforms, books and stationery, often being higher than they can afford.



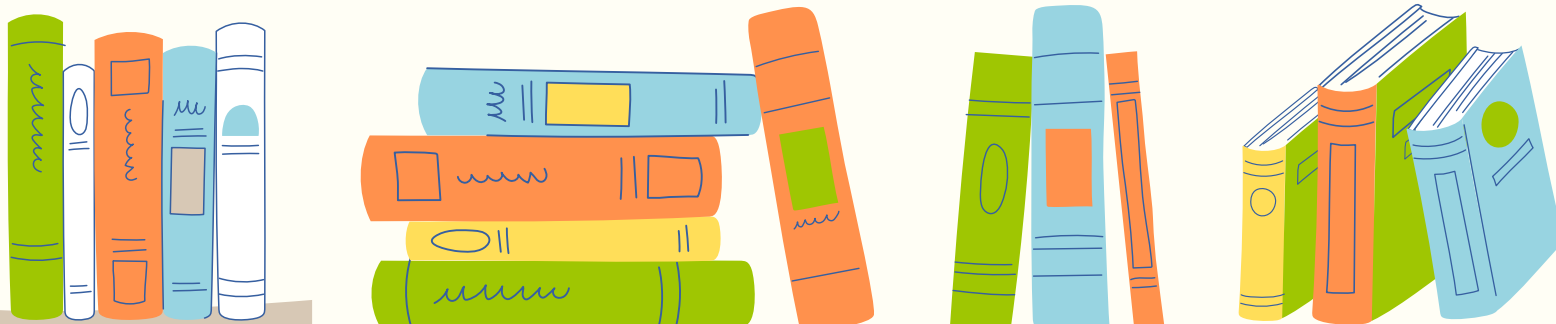
AllKids Solutions

Through the Kids to School project, AllKids provide students with all the materials which they need and the team work closely with local public schools to financially assist vulnerable families, allowing even the most underprivileged children access to education.

Often poorer villagers live long distances from schools where land values are lower. Their houses can be beyond walking distance from the closest school and there are no public transport systems, meaning the children simply don't go to school.



AllKids have also trained local contractors to provide regular school bus services to take the children from their homes to the learning centres or school.

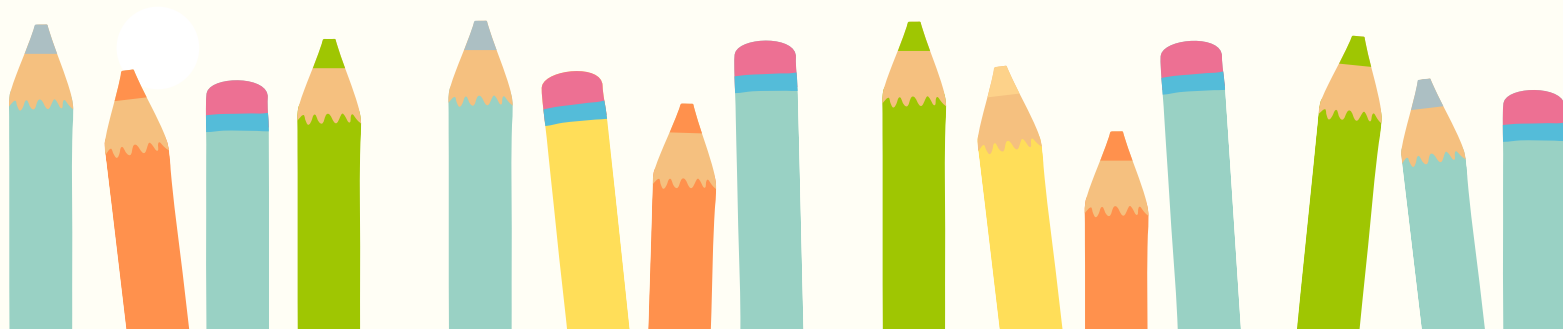

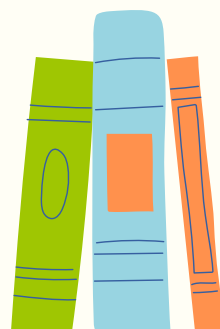

How it works

Children in developing countries on sponsorship programs inevitably stay in school for longer, have better learning outcomes, and better health than children not receiving support.

AllKids don't give money to children or their families. Rather, sponsorship funds the AllKids "Kids to School" program which enables more than 500 disadvantaged kids to go to public school and attend the AllKids Learning Centre. Each child on the program, whether they have a sponsor or not, receive the same assistance including school bus transport, school uniforms, books and stationery, health and dental care and family support.

AllKids sponsorships are a way to keep you, the sponsors, up to date with what we are achieving at AllKids through the progress of your sponsor child.
